

Speech therapist

For an adult everyday life, it is very important to have a good elocution, to be understood. Having a good elocution enhances self-confidence, personality and make easier interactions and communication with others. Therefore, any infantile language impairment (due to a problem of adaptation or a personal conflict) must be taken over and cured as soon as possible. Otherwise, this language impairment could trigger some frustration for your child, and this could have a negative impact on his / her emotional development.

Speech therapy cures the following child disorders:

- Child dyslalia: after four years-old, the child is still unable to correctly pronounce sounds (except for the letter "R", because here speech therapy is advised if the language impairment lasts after five years-old).
- Stuttering: the child often repeats short words or first syllables. How many times the word must be repeated can vary from twice or three times to ten or twelve times.
- General language developmental delay: the child sparsely speaks, don't ask or doesn't speak at all.
- Dyslexia: the child is unable to read all letters of a word.
- Dysgraphia: the child is unable to correctly write a word, he / she forgets some letters or group of letters.
- Psychogenic muteness.
- Autism.

To obtain best results and offer personalised proposals of treatment, our speech therapists also rely on the following elements:

- Cognitive psychology. This method studies processes and executive functions (perception, attention, language, memory, problem-solving ability, creativity, thinking) and how the child reacts to different stimulus.
- Developmental psychology. This method studies every psychologic change happening during a child's life.

Thus, each session is interactive and activities aim at developing the child's language and communication skills, as well as developing of every processes and functions involved in cognition and the child's mental development.

Each session lasts 50 minutes, and costs 50 Ron.
